We also arrange readings, poetry slams and talks on nature conservation and sustainability. Additional activities include courses for adults and children, which are held in the building. These range from tango to chess.



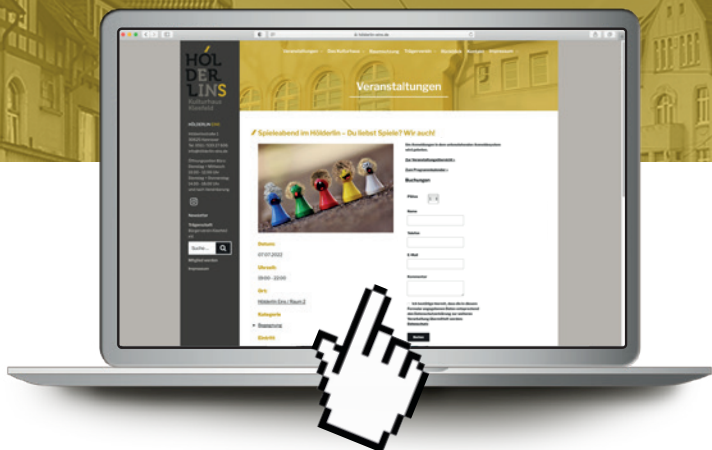
Time for kids

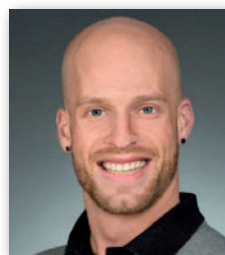
*The cultural centre is wheelchair accessible.
